With the help of the da Vinci surgical robot, surgeons are able to see 10 times closer than the naked eye with three-dimensional, high definition magnification. The robot's computer-guided instruments give doctors more precision and control than ever before.

Patient Benefits

Robot-assisted surgery techniques translate into several key patient benefits, all stemming from the use of smaller incisions. Since the incisions are small, there is less blood loss and usually less postoperative pain. Additionally, patients realize a shorter hospital stay and faster recovery. Depending on the surgery, many patients go home the same day.

Excela is the first health care organization in the region outside of Pittsburgh to have the da Vinci system. Initially, its primary uses are for:
