PREREQUISITES for APPLICATION:

- Registered Nurse
- Bachelor of Science in Nursing, or Bachelor's degree with RN associate degree or diploma. **Minimum overall GPA of 3.00 or above**; based on a 4.00 scale.
- Minimum of one year critical care experience¹ prior to entrance to the school.
- An undergraduate **Statistics course** within the past 10 years.
- Undergraduate or graduate level Chemistry within the past 7 years. If needed, must be completed by the December 15th deadline to be considered for interview.
- BLS certification
- ACLS certification
- Professional Resume
- Computer literacy is strongly recommended –ability to send and receive emails, open and send email attachments, use of Microsoft Word, ability to perform basic PowerPoint.
- Three letters of professional reference; one must come from your current nurse manager.
- Mature, professional demeanor.

GRE'S are not required.
